

How to Register for Economics A294: Introduction to Fisheries Economics and Markets

SUMMARY

Anyone can register for the course online following the steps at www.uaa.alaska.edu/admissions/wizard.cfm. If you are not a current University of Alaska student, you may need to apply for admission as a non-degree-seeking student, which is easy and free. The Fall 2009 course registration number (CRN) is 80994. You can telephone 907-786-1480 for assistance with registration. The total cost of this three-credit course for Alaska residents is about \$440 (some fees depend on what other courses you are taking).

IF YOU ARE CURRENTLY IN A UAA DEGREE PROGRAM OR HAVE TAKEN UAA COURSES IN THE PAST TWO YEARS:

You can register in the same way you would for any other course following these steps at: www.uaonline.alaska.edu

- Log in to Secure Account
- Select the Student Services, Financial Aid & Account Information tab
- Select REGISTRATION
- Select Term (Fall 2008)
- Select: Register/add/drop classes
- Enter the CRN#(80994)
- SUBMIT
- The screen will show the course you have registered for
- Scroll to the bottom of the page select “Complete Your Registration”
- This will calculate tuition and fees due for the course.
- From here you can select to pay online or you can pay in person at the University Center in Anchorage.

After you have registered go to the www.uaa.alaska.edu/distanceeducation website for information on how to sign in to Blackboard to access the course.

IF YOU ARE NOT CURRENTLY IN A UAA DEGREE PROGRAM OR HAVE NOT TAKEN UAA COURSES IN THE PAST TWO YEARS:

Before you can register, you need to apply for admissions. You can apply as a non-degree seeking student. This is easy and free. To apply, follow the instructions at www.uaa.alaska.edu/admissions/wizard.cfm. When you get to the page named “Select an Application Type,” for “Campus” choose “University of Alaska Anchorage,” and for “Program” choose “Non-degree seeking.”

Then to go to www.uaonline.alaska.edu:

- Select Login to Secured Area (students, staff, & faculty)
- Select “If you do not know your UA ID number, look up your ID here”
- Use the 8 digit UA ID number to log in to the secured area. The default pin will be your date of birth (mmddyy)
- When you are in your personal account you can register for the course. Follow the instructions listed above starting with “Select REGISTRATION.”
